Membership Requirements Checklist 2020-2021

Each active must complete the following to remain in good standing within the JLGC.

Criteria for Satisfactory Placement:

_____ Active members are required to sign the Criteria for Satisfactory Placement for any Committee or Placement for which they serve, indicating that they understand and will fulfill the requirements listed there.

Core Values and Standards of Behavior and Confidentiality Statement:

_____ Members are required to have a signed Core Values and Standards of Behavior and a Confidentiality Statement for the Junior League of Galveston County, Inc. on file with the Membership

Vice President.

Background Check:

_____ All members must submit to a background check.

Holiday Ball:

_____ Although Holiday Ball will not be held this League Year due to COVID-19, members are still responsible for the typical \$ 185 fundraising requirement. All members may choose to combine fundraising efforts to add up to at least the \$185 and/ or volunteer for a specific task that the fundraising committee values to be at least \$185 that is approved by the fund development vice president. Note that this is separate from the 20 credit requirement listed below. This will offer more flexibility during this trying time, but continue to maintain League standards. The \$185 will be due by March 1, 2020.

Attendance at Annual Dinner:

All members are required to attend the Annual Dinner in May. A member absent from this meeting shall pay five dollars (\$5) if she meets the reservations deadline and is unable to attend. A member absent from Annual Dinner and not meeting the reservations deadline shall be assessed the cost of the dinner and a fine of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00).

Spring Placement Interview Participation:

_____ All Provisional, Transfer, and first year Active Members are required to participate in Spring Placement Interviews and complete the placement survey. All other members must complete the placement survey.

Payment of Dues:

Dues for the following League year shall be payable by March 1, 2020. Dues shall be delinquent after March 31st and a fifteen dollar (\$15.00) late fee will be assessed. Note: Removal from membership in bad standing will occur if dues are unpaid after April 15, 2020.

_____ Dues paid (\$135.00)

In addition to the above requirements, each Active Member must obtain 20 credits during the League year. Credit opportunities are as follows:

General Meeting Attendance:

Under the new credit system, 16 credits must be satisfied by attending General Meetings (2 credits are given per meeting). Up to two general meeting absences are allowed per League year.

Hosting an Epicurean Event	4 credits
Ticket purchase for one Epicurean Event	1 credit/ League member
Hosting/ organizing an event for your placement or committee	2 credit
Contributing at least a \$50 value item(s) to your committee or community project	1 credit
Participating in an event for your placement committee or community project	1 credit

Fundraising chairs may also offer opportunities for credits to be obtained monetarily during special situations.

Please note: Community hours earned toward credit **may now** be within your placement or committee.
